Day 1 Mon Feb 20 Departure

Depart **Regina** on your way to **Israel**
Overnight en route

Day 2 Tue Feb 21 Israel

Arrive at **Ben Gurion** airport, where you will be met and travel to **Tel Aviv**. Have a two hour visit to the **Biblical Gardens** at **Neot Kedumin**. Here you will see many different trees mentioned in the Bible, an olive press, and a threshing floor. Continue to **Jaffa (Joppa)** where Peter stayed with **Simon the Tanner** (Acts 10:13). This is also the place where Jonah sailed from when he went to Tarshish. This evening we will share our first Jewish meal together.

Overnight in Tel Aviv

Day 3 Wed Feb 22 Galilee

Drive along the **Mediterranean** coastline to **Caesarea**. We will have the opportunity to see the Archaeological ruins of the Roman Amphitheatre, the Aqueduct and the new Museum. From here we will travel to **Haifa** for a view of the bay. We will ascend to the top of **Mt. Carmel** and see the place where **Elijah** killed the 400 prophets of Baal. Then we will gather at **Megiddo**, the site of **Armageddon** for a short stop and learn about the final battle where the book of Revelation will come alive.

Overnight by the Sea of Galilee

Day 4 Thu Feb 23 Galilee - Golan Heights

Drive through the **Galilean** landscape to visit the **Basilica of the Annunciation** in **Nazareth** where Jesus grew up as a boy. Have some time for shopping. Drive via **Cana of Galilee** where Jesus had turned the water into wine. From here we will go to **Capernaum**, which was the place that Jesus chose to center his ministry. (Mark 2:1). Stop near **Tabgha** for lunch and have a time of sharing by the **Sea of Galilee**. Continue to **Golan Heights** to visit the **Banias**, site of **Caesarea Philippi**. Climb **Mt. Bental** for a view and briefing on the history and security of the **Golan Heights**. Drive to view **Hermon Mountain** by **Lebanon Border**.

Overnight by the Sea of Galilee

Day 5 Fri Feb 24 Galilee - Dead Sea

We will take a **boat ride** on the **Sea of Galilee**. Travel to **Mt. Of Beatitudes** where Jesus delivered the **Sermon on the Mount**. Go to the **Baptism** site on the **Jordan River** where John the Baptist, baptize Jesus. There will be opportunity for everyone to be baptized in the **Jordan River**. We will visit **Beth Shean** and tour the excavations that have revealed Israel's largest ruins of a Roman City. Stop to visit the **Island of Peace** at **Nahariam**. Enjoy a scenic drive down the **Jordan Valley** to the **Dead Sea**.

Overnight at the Dead Sea

Day 6 Sat Feb 25 Dead Sea

Enjoy a relaxing day in the **Dead Sea**. You can have a refreshing dip in the therapeutic salt mineral water of the **Dead Sea**, go for a walk or just sit in the sun. This is the **Sabbath** and many Jews from Jerusalem will be here to celebrate.

Overnight at the Dead Sea

Day 7 Sun Feb 26 Jerusalem

Take the Cable Car to the top of the mountain of **Massada**, King Herod's magnificent palace and fortress. Take a hike up to **Ein Gedi Falls**, the desert oasis where David hid from King Saul. Stop at **Qumran** where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** were discovered. Travel up to **Jerusalem** through the Judean Wilderness. Enter **Jerusalem** as a pilgrim and enjoy a view and a **Blessing** on top of **Mt. Scoups**

Overnight in Jerusalem

Day 8 Mon Feb 27 Jerusalem

Drive to **Mount Olives** to enjoy a view of the city of **Jerusalem**. Walk down the **Palm Sunday** path to **Dominus Flevit**, where Jesus wept over the city. Continue to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus prayed for God's will to be done and the **Church of All Nations**. On to **Mount Zion** to see **King David's Tomb** and the **Room of the Last Supper**. Explore the **Jewish Quarter**. Walk along the renovated **Cardo**, the Roman market street and see the **Hurva Synagogue**. Continue to visit the **Western Wall**. Explore the **Rabbi's Tunnel** beneath the Wall. Visit the **Pool of Bethesda** (John 5) **Saint Anne's Church** with its wonderful acoustics.

Overnight in Jerusalem

Day 9 Tue Feb 28 Jerusalem

Spend time at **Yad Vashem**, the Holocaust Memorial, visiting the museum and the Valley of the Jewish Communities. Continue to **Ramat Rachel** for a view of **Bethlehem**. Continue to the **Garden Tomb** with time to walk around the beautiful garden area and time for communion together. View the Hill of Golgotha's where Jesus died (Matthew 27:33-35). Continue to **Government Hill** to see the **Knesset, Israel's Parliament** and the **Menorah**, which is engraved with scenes of the Jewish Nations history.

Overnight in Jerusalem

Day 10 Wed Feb 29 Jerusalem

In the morning we will have an **Israeli soldier** share his experiences at our hotel. The rest of the day is for shopping or free time to do what you want in **Jerusalem**.

Day 1 Thu Mar 1 Israel - Egypt

Free day in **Jerusalem**. In the afternoon transfer to the airport to fly to **Cairo**

Day 2 Fri Mar 2 Cairo

You will drive by the **City of the Dead Cemetery** where many people live among the graves. Visit the **Papyrus Museum** and see how the inside pulp of papyrus plants is flattened, latticed, and pressed for 5 days. (In the Bible, Moses mother put him in a papyrus basket into the Nile River)
Overnight in Cairo

Day 4 Sun Mar 4 Cairo

Stop by the **Delta of the Nile River** and see the cotton and rice growing. Shop in a **Cotton store**, where authentic **Egyptian** cotton products can be purchased and taken back home. Shop at **Khan El Khalili Bazaar** the Big Souk with its endless little shops all manned by **Egyptian** men. End the day with a **Nile Dinner Cruise – Enjoy top-class service aboard your Nile cruise**, going past **Cairo's** illuminated skyline while you **dine**.
